2. What is the major claim Weintraub makes? Use evidence from the article to support your answer. Must be 3-5 sentences.

3. What is the major claim in McEwen's article? Use evidence from the article to support your answer. Must be 3-5 sentences.

1. What can you infer about Weintraub and McEwen from their articles? How do they present themselves in ways to make readers trust their viewpoints?

2. Do you trust both authors? Why or why not?
